



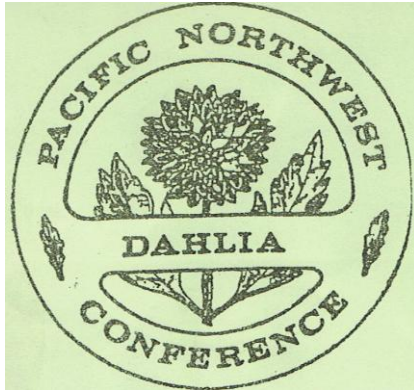

Judges and Clerks are asked to assemble at Center Court in the mall at 10:00 a.m. for briefing and assignments.
 Judging starts at 10:30 a.m.

When driving from the South, follow Hwy 19 as if heading for Campbell River. Turn right at the Northfield Road exit. At the first traffic light turn left on to Bowen Road. Go through the light at Hwy 19A (old island hwy) and follow around to the back of Country Club Centre.

If you arrive by B.C. Ferry, follow the highway directional signs heading North to Parksville and Campbell River. When you join Hwy 19A, check your odometer. Country Club Centre is 3.4 km North, on your right.

Exhibits may be placed the night before the show from approximately 9:00 p.m. when the mall is closed to the public. Placement of exhibits may continue through the night until 10:00 a.m. Saturday, August 20, 2011. **Best entrance for show exhibitors is at the rear of the mall.**

The show is open to the public during normal shopping hours and will end at 3.30 p.m. Sunday, August 21, 2011. **Exhibits should be removed at that time (but not earlier).**

Any blooms not removed will become the property of the Society. The Gladioli and dahlias will be given to people in the mall at shows end.

Exhibitors should pick up any ribbons they wish to keep at 2.30 p.m. Sunday, prior to the close of the show. Our show officials will retain for you all ribbons from Head Table at the end of the show. If you wish ribbons from other areas, please see the Show Chairperson. A list of your entries showing placement MUST ACCOMPANY your request.

Our annual banquet will be held the evening of Saturday, 20 Aug 2011, at 6.00pm followed by presentation of awards. Guests and non-members are welcome. Please inform the show chairman (His phone number and email address are shown on page 2.)

- 1 BASKET 400-500 One or more varieties and colours
(front facing).
- 2 BASKET 100-200-300 One or more varieties and colours
(front facing).
- 3 BASKET 100-200-300 One or more varieties and colors. (To
be viewed from front and back)

Gladioli spikes in Sections 20 and 21 require a pair of leaves

All decorative classes may contain any natural green foliage, and/or small flowering plants i.e.. Baby's breath or sea lavender. Decorative classes are judged 50% for quality of bloom and 50% for quality of arrangement, i.e. decorative effect.

A **SECTION CHAMPION** will be selected from each of Sections 1-21. **BEST GLADIOLUS** in show to be selected from the Section Champions of Open sections 1,2,3,10,11,12,13,14,15, 19 and Novice sections 1 and 2

The Show is open to all exhibitors. There are no entry fees.

1. Dahlias will be exhibited according to A.D.S. classification. The P.N.D.C. supplementary listing will be used where applicable. A minor fault will be assessed for undersized or oversized blooms. Dahlias not listed in the ADS booklet will be shown in the appropriate size, type and colour class. The Show Chairman or any Senior Judge will aid in classifying any new variety or any not named in the official list and will mark the exhibitor's tag.

2. Exhibitors categories are JUNIOR, NOVICE, AMATEUR, and OPEN competition. An exhibitor shall show in Novice for three years, then in Amateur for three years, but may advance before the three year maximum.

3. Exhibitors shall obtain tags from the show secretary and fill out a tag for each exhibit. An exhibitor's category is determined by how long he/she has been exhibiting in the shows of any Dahlia Club, which is a member of the ADS.

4. **Exhibitors will not require an exhibitor's number, but the entry tags MUST BE COMPLETED correctly TOP & BOTTOM**

5. Dahlias must be shown disbudded and with the first pair of leaves showing above the container. The use of any material above the top of the container to support the dahlia will disqualify the entry.

6. Containers and Styrofoam will be supplied by the society. In the Decorative Section, exhibitors shall supply their own baskets and bowls. The Society cannot be responsible for damage to personal property.

7. Exhibitors may make as many entries as desired in any one class if each entry is of a different variety.

8. The Exhibitor must have grown all blooms shown in the competition, except in the Seedling Classes.

9. The show committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.

10. Judges may withhold an award if entries are unworthy or award a second if any entry is unworthy of a first.

11. A bowl is a container having a diameter at the mouth at least equal to but usually greater than its height.

12. Aggregate points will be computed as follows:

Single Entry: Blue 3, Red 2

Triple Entry: Blue 6, Red 4

Best of Type: Same as blue in class

Section Champions: Same as blue in class

Bowl: Blue 9, Red 6

Basket: Blue 12, Red 8

NO points are awarded for seedlings.

8 In sections 1 - 23, entries must be shown complete, with nothing added and nothing removed, except that fallen pollen may be removed, and that side shoots must be removed.

- 9 Stem length should be approximately
 400-500 -20 inches

Any significant variation may be penalized at the judges' discretion.

10 Use of any material to support the exhibit above the container shall disqualify the entry. This does not refer to vase stuffing or to a peg or wedge.

11 The show committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.

12 Judges may withhold an award if entries are unworthy or award a second if any entry is unworthy of a first.

13 A Vase is a container having a diameter at the mouth less than the measure of its height.

14 A basket is a decorative, generally flared container with a fixed handle, and may be made of woven wicker, metal, paper, paper mache, plastic, crochet, or even lace, with a water proof liner.

15 Aggregate points will be computed as follows:

- 1. Spike: Blue 3, Red 2
- 3 Spikes: Blue 6, Red 4
- 5 Spikes: Blue 9, Red 6
- Baskets & Vases Blue 12, Red 8

GENERAL RULES – GLADIOLI

The show is open to all exhibitors

1. The 2011 N.A.G.C. Classification will be used by the exhibitors in staging the Gladioli entries and is the authority in case of dispute. Where a variety is not listed in the N.A.G.C. Classification, the C.G.S. will apply. A Classification Committee will rule on any blooms unclassified. All blooms must have their complete classification on the tag prior to staging.

2. Exhibitors categories are **NOVICE** and **OPEN**. An exhibitor may show in the **NOVICE** category for three years, but may enter **OPEN** category at any time. The three years as a **NOVICE** includes any show affiliated with the Canadian Gladiolus Society. A professional gardener or commercial grower shall enter in **OPEN** category.

3. Exhibitors shall obtain tags from the show secretary and show the variety and name of every entry on the entry tag provided, including the Basket and Vase Classes.

NOVICE Category **PINK** tags
OPEN Category **WHITE** tags

The exhibitor’s name and address should be written in the spaces provided, on both top and bottom of entry tag.

4. Flowers shall be shown in containers as supplied by the Society, except in Basket and Vase classes; for which the exhibitor shall furnish their own containers. The Society cannot be responsible for loss or damage to any container.

5. Exhibitors may make as many entries as they desire in any class, provided the entries are of different varieties.

6. All blooms must be grown by the exhibitor.

7. Glad spikes must be shown with 2 leaves.
